≤120 words, single paragraph: “question → conclusion”

3. Thematic Section-by-Section Breakdown

- One H2 heading per section
- Each section ≥500 words
- Methods / frameworks / processes → bullet steps

- Key numbers, definitions, verbatim quotes kept; English gloss & note in brackets
- Ambiguous statements retained and tagged “[original phrasing unclear]”

4. Framework & Mindset (abstract models)

≥500 words per model; bullet steps
Only models explicitly mentioned in the audio—no new ones added

Style Rules (non-negotiable)

- Never heavily condense!
- No new facts; mark uncertainty where original is fuzzy
- Keep proper nouns in original language + English gloss in brackets
- Avoid wall-of-text paragraphs; use bulleted logic splits

Quality Gate (auto-check)

- [] Every section ≥500 words & readable stand-alone
- [] 100% retention of key numbers / verbatim quotes
- [] All unclear spots flagged
- [] Proper nouns glossed
- [] Only audio-explicit frameworks used
